### What can learners expect?

- Implementing promotional instructions
- Dispatching stock
- Uplifting stock for return



### Mode of delivery

This programme is delivered through contact sessions that will provide the learner with the interpersonal support for learning to take place. Furthermore, a workplace component will allow the learner to apply knowledge gained in a workplace environment.
