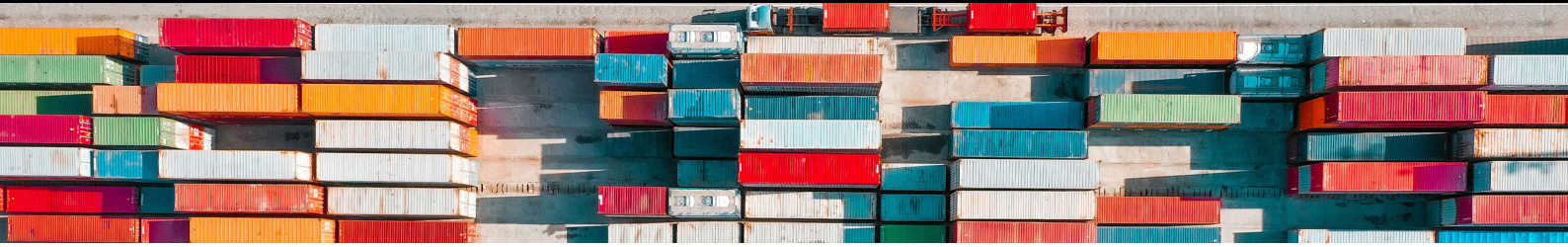

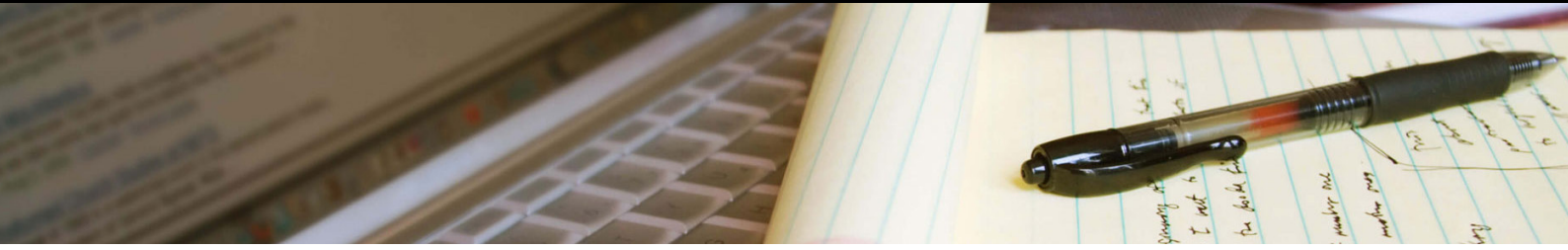

SKILLS PROGRAMMES



Moderator - NQF Level 6

This programme is intended for conducting internal and external moderation of outcomes-based assessments.

Admission Requirements

Individuals will need previous assessment experience and recognition for unit standard 115753: Conduct outcomes-based assessments.

Duration

The programme can be completed in 4 days (32 hours) and learners will be given 1 week to complete a Portfolio of Evidence.

Skills Development Facilitator (SDF) - NQF Level 5

This programme intends to empower potential SDF's who will oversee or manage education, training and skills development within an organisation according to agreed development plans and legislation.

Admission Requirements

Communication, Mathematics and Computer Literacy at NQF Level 4.

Duration

The programme can be completed in 5 days (40 hours) and learners will be given 5 weeks to complete a Portfolio of Evidence.

Assessor - NQF Level 5

In this programme, learners will learn how to conduct and review assessments in their field of expertise. Individuals who provide a basic level of support to learners about learning and assessment needs, such as HR managers and supervisors, will benefit from this programme.

Admission Requirements

Evaluative expertise within the area of learning in which they intend to assess.

Duration

The programme can be completed in 4 days (32 hours) and learners will be given 1 week to complete a Portfolio of Evidence.



Train the Trainer - NQF Level 5

The purpose of this programme is to learn how to plan and prepare a learning event, as well as to facilitate programmes, using a range of methods and techniques.

Admission Requirements

Numeracy and Literacy at NQF Level 4.

Duration

The programme can be completed in 5 days (40 hours) and learners will be given 3 weeks to complete a Portfolio of Evidence.

Coaching and Mentoring (Assist and Support) - NQF Level 4

This programme will benefit individuals who are involved in assisting and supporting learners and individuals who provide a basic level of support to learners about learning and assessment needs such as Human Resource managers and supervisors.

Admission Requirements

Communication at NQF Level 3. Knowledge and understanding of education, training and development practices.

Duration

The programme can be completed in 3 days (24 hours) and learners will be given 3 weeks to complete a Portfolio of Evidence.
